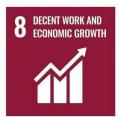

#### Commitment to Students

BSU remains steadfast in its commitment to safeguarding the safety and well-being of its students. By fostering a culture of respect, responsibility, and care, the university strives to empower students to thrive academically, personally, and socially.







## **Objectives**

- Ensure Safety and Security: Safeguard students from harm, discrimination, harassment, and abuse.
- **Promote Well-Being:** Foster an environment that nurtures mental, emotional, and social health.
- Encourage Empowerment: Equip students with the skills and resources to safeguard their well-being and contribute to a safe academic community.
- Establish Accountability: Define clear roles, responsibilities, and procedures to address safety and well-being concerns.

#### Scope

This policy applies to all BSU students, faculty, staff, and visitors, covering activities on campus, during virtual interactions, and in university-endorsed events and programs.

## **Core Principles**

- Inclusivity: Respect and value diversity, ensuring a welcoming environment for individuals from all backgrounds.
- **Proactivity:** Emphasize prevention through awareness, training, and preparation.
- Responsiveness: Commit to swift and appropriate responses to safety and well-being concerns.
- **Collaboration:** Work collectively with students, staff, local authorities, and external partners to maintain high standards of safety.

#### SAFETY AND WELL-BEING FRAMEWORK

### Campus Security and Infrastructure

- 24/7 presence of trained security personnel.
- Installation of surveillance cameras in strategic areas.
- Regular maintenance of campus facilities, ensuring accessibility and safety.
- Emergency stations and first-aid kits located across the campus.

### Physical Health and Safety

- Medical clinics available for health consultations and emergency care.
- Regular health screenings and vaccination programs.
- Campus-wide safety drills for fire, earthquake, and other emergencies.

## Mental Health and Emotional Well-Being

- Access to counseling and psychological support services.
- Regular workshops on stress management, mindfulness, and resiliencebuilding.
- Programs to combat stigma surrounding mental health challenges.

## Academic and Intellectual Safety

- Transparent policies on academic fairness and integrity.
- Mechanisms to address grievances related to teaching, grading, or workload.
- Safeguards against academic exploitation or undue pressure.

#### Digital Safety and Data Security

- Safe and secure online platforms for academic and administrative activities.
- Awareness programs on cyberbullying, phishing, and online privacy.
- Monitoring and addressing inappropriate behavior on digital platforms.

### Off-Campus Activities and Global Engagement

- Pre-departure orientation and safety briefings for international students and those participating in fieldwork or internships.
- Emergency contact mechanisms for students studying or traveling abroad.

 Collaboration with local and international partners to ensure safety during exchange programs.

#### REPORTING, RESPONSE, AND RESOLUTION

#### Reporting Mechanisms

- Multiple channels for reporting concerns, including anonymous options.
- Designated points of contact in departments and administrative units.
- Clear communication of reporting protocols to all students.

#### Response to Incidents

- Immediate action to assess and address reported issues.
- Coordination with law enforcement or external authorities if required.
- Support services for affected individuals, including counseling and medical care.

## Resolution and Accountability

- Transparent and impartial investigation of all reported incidents.
- Appropriate sanctions or remedial actions based on findings.
- Continuous monitoring of outcomes to prevent recurrence.

## **Education and Training**

- Orientation programs for new students on safety and well-being policies.
- Periodic training for students and staff on emergency preparedness and conflict resolution.
