Description:

As part of the university's commitment to sustainable waste management, a comprehensive 3R (Reduce, Reuse, Recycle) Program has been implemented to minimize waste generation and improve resource efficiency across campus. The program emphasizes reducing waste at the source, reusing materials whenever possible, and recycling segregated waste through licensed recycling partners.

During the previous reporting year, the university generated a total of 290 tons of solid waste, comprising 137 tons of plastic waste and 153 tons of paper waste. Through the successful implementation of waste reduction initiatives—including digitalization of administrative processes, reduced use of single-use plastics, paperless learning and communication, reuse of office materials and furniture, and campus-wide recycling practices—the university achieved a 40% reduction in waste generation during the current year.

As a result, plastic waste decreased from 137 tons to 82.2 tons, while paper waste decreased from 153 tons to 91.8 tons. Overall, the total amount of waste generated was reduced from 290 tons to 174 tons, representing a reduction of 116 tons compared with the previous year.

This achievement demonstrates the effectiveness of the university's integrated 3R strategy and reflects the active participation of students, staff, and administrative units in promoting responsible consumption, resource conservation, and environmental sustainability. The program also contributes to the university's commitment to the United Nations Sustainable Development Goal (SDG) 12: Responsible Consumption and Production, while supporting broader institutional sustainability objectives.
