Description:

Sustainability-related scholarly publications produced by Baku State University (BSU) during a one-year reporting period. It demonstrates the University's strong research capacity and its commitment to generating scientific knowledge that contributes to environmental sustainability, social development, economic resilience, and the achievement of the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs).

During the reporting period, BSU's 965 lecturers and researchers produced a total of 3,474 sustainability-related scholarly publications, including peer-reviewed journal articles, conference proceedings, books, book chapters, technical reports, policy papers, and other academic outputs. These publications span a wide range of disciplines and reflect the University's interdisciplinary approach to sustainability research.

The Faculty of International Relations & Economics is among the leading contributors, producing 304 publications that address topics such as sustainable economic development, international cooperation, governance, public policy, and sustainable finance. The Faculty of Law contributed 275 publications, focusing on environmental law, human rights, sustainable governance, climate policy, and legal frameworks supporting sustainable development. The Faculty of Philology produced 257 publications, examining sustainability through language, culture, education, communication, and social development perspectives.

The natural science faculties also make significant contributions. The Faculty of History published 239 scholarly works, while the Faculty of Biology produced 221 publications related to biodiversity, ecosystem conservation, genetics, and environmental sciences. The Faculties of Physics and Geology & Soil Sciences each generated 206 publications, supporting research in renewable energy, environmental monitoring, geosciences, climate systems, and natural resource management. The Faculty of Chemistry contributed 199 publications, emphasizing green chemistry, environmental analysis, pollution control, and sustainable materials.

Additional contributions came from the Faculty of Ecology (181 publications), Journalism (174), Social Sciences & Psychology (167), Geography (163), Oriental Studies (138), Applied Mathematics (127), Document Management (112), and Mechanics & Mathematics (105). These publications cover diverse themes including environmental education, sustainable communication, geographic information systems, disaster risk reduction, digital sustainability, data analytics, and mathematical modelling for sustainable development.

Beyond the academic faculties, Other Research Institutes and Interdisciplinary Research Centers produced 800 sustainability-related publications, representing the largest institutional contribution. These research units undertake multidisciplinary projects involving climate change adaptation, environmental technologies, biodiversity conservation, renewable energy, sustainable agriculture, public health, artificial intelligence for sustainability, water resource management, and innovation aligned with national priorities and international sustainability agendas.

Overall, the production of 3,474 sustainability-related scholarly publications within a single year demonstrates BSU's robust research ecosystem and its strategic investment in interdisciplinary research. The broad participation of faculties across the natural sciences, engineering, social sciences, humanities, and specialized research institutes highlights that sustainability is embedded throughout the University's research mission rather than being confined to a single discipline. This extensive scholarly output strengthens BSU's national and international research profile while contributing evidence-based solutions to global sustainability challenges and supporting progress toward the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs).
