BSU is actively committed to fostering sustainable development, both directly and indirectly by shaping SDG policies and facilitating their implementation. BSU actively collaborates with governments, international institutions, and non-governmental organizations (NGOs) in organizing events focused on SDGs and their elements. The University department of Gender and Applied Psychology also plays a vital role in international conferences, such as the worldwide feminine international conference in AZC, along with other relevant engagements in association with UNDP Azerbaijan.

In line with our commitment to addressing climate change and its impact on water resources, BSU collaborates closely with the Water Users Union, UNDP, and the United Nations Food and Agriculture Organization. BSU has different policies (for more details, please see the respective policies provided): on accommodation, sustainable procurement and investment, anti-financial and anti-discrimination, student-led society, climate action, equality, diversity and inclusion, anti-bribery and anti-corruption, holistic ethics, organizational culture. All above-mentioned policies contribute and foster sustainability within the University through existing processes and awareness toward the respective issues. The SDGs are currently the focus of a number of structured trainings or educational programs at BSU. Parallel to this, various SDG-related subjects, such as "Introduction to Gender," "Sustainable Development Goals in Azerbaijan," "Green" and "Blue" Economy, "Food Security and Sustainable Development," "Urbanization and Urban Planning," etc., are covered in the pertinent academic programs.

Beginning with the 2019-2020 academic year, Baku State University will offer a bachelor's degree program in "Sustainable Development Management." As previously mentioned, specific courses on SDG areas are also included in the various study programs. Examples include "Introduction to Gender," "Azerbaijan's Sustainable Development Goals," "The Green and Blue Economy," "Food Security and Sustainable Development," "Urbanization and Urban Planning," and others. They lead to the award of an officially recognized qualification that specifically refers to climate science and environmental sustainability.

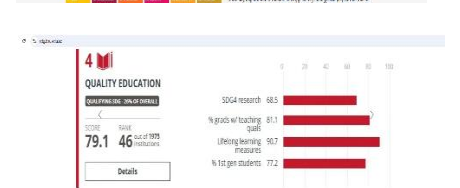
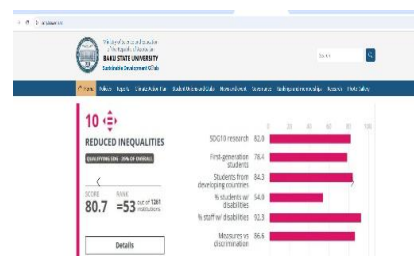
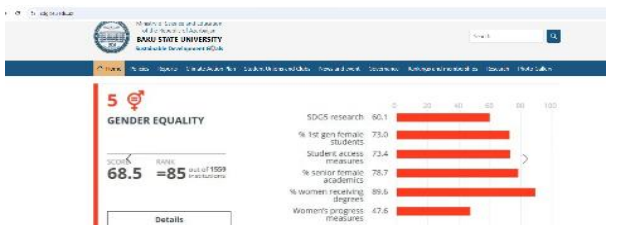
Active Branches of the Center:

Sustainable Development Goals (SDG) Committee

Overview

The Sustainable Development Goals (SDG) Committee at Baku State University (BSU) is dedicated to advancing sustainability initiatives and integrating the UN's 17 Sustainable Development Goals into the university's academic, research, and operational activities. The committee serves as a platform for collaboration among faculty, students, and external partners to promote sustainability and drive impactful change.

Mission and Objectives

The SDG Committee aims to:

- Foster awareness and engagement with the SDGs across the BSU community.
- Incorporate sustainability principles into teaching, research, and campus operations.
- Establish partnerships with national and international organizations to support SDG-related initiatives.
- Monitor and report on the university's progress in achieving the SDGs.
- Organize events, workshops, and projects that promote sustainable practices and social responsibility.

Key Focus Areas

The SDG Committee prioritizes initiatives that align with the university's strategic goals, including:

- **Quality Education (SDG 4):** Enhancing educational programs to include sustainability themes.
- **Climate Action (SDG 13):** Reducing the university's environmental footprint through green campus initiatives.
- **Partnerships for the Goals (SDG 17):** Strengthening collaborations with local and global institutions.
- **Gender Equality (SDG 5):** Promoting inclusivity and equal opportunities within the academic environment.
- **Innovation and Infrastructure (SDG 9):** Supporting research and technological advancements that contribute to sustainable development.

Committee Structure

The SDG Committee consists of representatives from various university departments, including faculty members, administrative staff, and student organizations. The committee is led by a chairperson and operates through specialized working groups focused on specific SDGs.

Sustainability Office

Sustainability Office (Baku State University) The Sustainability Office at Baku State University (BSU) is the university’s dedicated operational unit responsible for the practical implementation and coordination of sustainability and Sustainable Development Goals (SDG)-related activities across the institution. It is staffed by full-time employees who are responsible for ensuring continuous execution of sustainability initiatives, data management, and institutional reporting. The Office serves as the central coordination point between academic departments, administrative units, and external stakeholders to embed sustainability into all areas of university operations. The core responsibilities of the Sustainability Office include the day-to-day management of sustainability programs, coordination of SDG-related projects, monitoring and analysis of institutional sustainability performance indicators (such as energy, water, waste, and emissions), and preparation of sustainability reports for internal governance and international reporting frameworks. In addition, the Office is responsible for implementing the university’s annual sustainability work plan, which includes climate action activities,

Through its continuous operational work and full-time staffing structure, the Sustainability Office ensures the effective implementation and long-term institutionalization of BSU's sustainability agenda.

- **Monitoring and assessing progress** toward the achievement of the SDGs through independent academic research.
- **Integrating sustainability principles** into



university education, research agendas, and institutional policies.

- **Facilitating dialogue and cooperation** between academia, government institutions, international organizations, and civil society.





Core Functions and Activities

The Quality Assurance Center coordinates a wide range of sustainability-related initiatives on campus, including:

- Conducting **interdisciplinary research** related to environmental, social, and economic dimensions of sustainable development.
- Organizing **international and national conferences, workshops, and seminars** focused on sustainability challenges and solutions.
- Publishing **analytical reports, policy briefs, and academic publications** related to SDGs implementation.
- Supporting **capacity-building programs and training** for students, academic staff, policymakers, and practitioners.
- Promoting **research collaboration and partnerships** with national and international universities, research institutions, and development organizations.
- Encouraging **student engagement and volunteer initiatives** related to sustainability and social responsibility.
- Facilitating the **exchange of research findings and best practices** among academic and policy communities.
